

Update Regarding Skylake Pool:

It has come to the Board's attention that the existing Board Approved Pool Rules have not been consistently followed nor equitably enforced. Thus, the purpose of this letter is to inform or re-acquaint all Skylake Property Owners of the existing pool procedures and rules. Adherence to the procedures and rules will ensure the pool is an enjoyable and safe amenity for all.

- The pool is open from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. daily.
- Please remember that *guests must be accompanied by a Skylake Property Owner* or a 21 years or older member of the Property Owner's family. Property Owners are responsible for the actions of their guests.
- *Pool cards should never be transferred to a non-Skylake Property Owner.*
- Anyone not in possession of their pool card will be asked to leave the pool area.
- Property Owners/Residents must sign the roster on the clipboard beneath the cabana.
- It is the responsibility of the Pool Monitor to require all pool participants to comply with all Board approved pool procedures and rules.

The Board requests that the facilities be used in a safe and considerate manner at all times. Failure to comply with the procedures or rules can result in any of the following: immediate removal from the pool, loss of pool privileges, cancellation of pool card, and/or calling the White County Sheriff's Department.

To further ensure the Skylake POA pool remains a safe and enjoyable amenity for all Property Owners and their guests, *any large group* (12 to a maximum of 25) must register with the Skylake office PRIOR to the event, complete the registration form, and follow the rules outlined on the form.

There is no lifeguard on duty, thus persons swim at their own risk. Animals, other than service dogs, are not allowed in the pool area. Tables and chairs are provided for the convenience of pool users and should be returned to the original location prior to leaving the pool area. Umbrellas should be closed and secured prior to leaving the pool area as well.

In case of emergency, call the Guardhouse (706-878-3480). A first-aid kit and defibrillator are available at the Guardhouse.

SKYLAKE POOL RULES

- 1. NO UNSUPERVISED CHILDREN (LESS THAN 15 YEARS OF AGE) ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR THE POOL AREA.**
- 2. SWIM DIAPERS ARE REQUIRED FOR CHILDREN NOT TOILET TRAINED.**
- 3. APPROPRIATE SWIMWEAR IS REQUIRED. NO CUTOFFS.**
- 4. NO GLASS ARTICLES ARE ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE POOL AREA.**
- 5. NO FOOD OR DRINKS OF ANY KIND ARE PERMITTED WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE POOL.**
- 6. NO SMOKING INSIDE OR WITHIN 15 FEET OF THE POOL ENCLOSURE.**
- 7. NO RUNNING, ROUGH PLAY, OR PROFANITY ALLOWED.**
- 8. NO SWIMMING WITH OPEN WOUNDS, INFECTIOUS OR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES.**
- 9. PETS AND OTHER ANIMALS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE POOL AREA (EXCEPT SERVICE DOGS)**
- 10. NO SWIMMING WHILE THUNDER IS HEARD OR LIGHTNING SIGHTED. POOL MUST BE VACATED FOR 30 MINUTES FROM THE LAST SOUND OR SIGHTING OF THUNDER/LIGHTNING.**

RESIDENTS/PROPERTY OWNERS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE POOL RULES WILL HAVE THEIR POOL PRIVILEGES REVOKED AND THEIR POOL CARD CANCELLED.
